Dr. Fleur van Leeuwen is an international law scholar with a particular interest in gender and law. She has over twenty years of experience in research, lecturing, consultancy and advocacy. Fleur has written extensively on women's rights, including on violence against women, sexual and reproductive rights, and gender mainstreaming. She has advised international organizations, including the EU and the UN, as well as civil society organizations and national parliaments on gender and law. Besides her position at Boğaziçi University she is a senior affiliated researcher at Atria - Institute on Gender Equality and Women's History in Amsterdam, the Netherlands and is the Editor-in-Chief of the Dutch Journal of Genderstudies. Before her move to Turkey Fleur worked for many years at the Netherlands Institute of Human Rights.

Research interests: Feminist legal theory, feminist approaches to international law, feminist theory, non-discrimination law, gender mainstreaming, women's human rights, international human rights law, actor-oriented perspectives on human rights, violence against women, sexual and reproductive rights, human rights in childbirth, maternal health care, obstetric violence, critical international legal theory, human rights advocacy, human rights monitoring.
